Ruth Gavison

Every Yom Kippur, at Yizkor, we honor the memories of our loved ones, who taught us when they lived and inspire us no matter how many years ago it's been since they died. We hope to carry on their values and priorities, thereby keeping their memory alive. They made a profound difference in our lives.

On the list of notable Jewish deaths in 5780, we find people who made extraordinary contributions to medicine, philosophy, sociology, the arts, and the spiritual lives of the Jewish People. We also lost a number of fighters for justice and equality. Scan the list and you'll see the names of people who stood up against tyranny in its various forms, who supported victims of hate and oppression, and who sheltered the vulnerable. But the death of one advocate for justice stands out this year.

Ruth Gavison was one of my heroines. She was an Israeli patriot, defender of Israel as a Jewish and democratic state, and one of the great legal minds of our times. She was nominated for a seat on Israel's Supreme Court, but she was blocked, likely for her opposition to judicial activism. She believed that the principles around various divides in Israel—Jewish/Democratic, religious/secular, Arab/Jewish—should be set by the Knesset, since the legislature reflects the wishes of the citizenry most accurately.

Perhaps her greatest achievement was the Gavison-Medan Covenant, a draft of a framework for coexistence between religious and secular Jews, co-authored with Rabbi Yaakov Medan of Yeshivat Har Etzyon. In it, she wrote: "May our core differences not jeopardize our ability to promote what is shared between us." She insisted that in any dispute, both parties must be prepared to make hard sacrifices, to compromise for the sake of harmony.

Professor Gavison served on the faculty at the Hebrew University law school for 30 years, and was one of Israel's most revered jurists. When she died, tributes came from every sector of the Israeli political spectrum. Former justice minister Ayeled

Shaked said it well: “Every justice minister used to consult with Ruth regardless of the ideology he or she believed in.”

English-speaking audiences would have been most familiar with Professor Gavison’s essay *The Jews’ Right to Statehood: A Defense*, published in the academic journal *Azure* in 2003, near the end of the Terror War (aka Second Intifada). Her legal, philosophical, and moral arguments are impressive. I encourage you to read the entire essay; it remains as relevant today as it was when it first appeared. Here is the concluding paragraph of the essay:

“It is not for us to finish the job,’ we are told by the rabbis of the Talmud. Our generation is not responsible for establishing a Jewish state; rather, we are responsible for preserving it for future generations, and for ensuring that it is passed on to our children as a worthy inheritance. This requires that we give them solid grounds for believing in the justice of our common enterprise—and this, in turn, means recognizing the diversity of Israel’s citizenry and the complexity of our life together. Our generation needs to channel this diversity to good ends, even when different groups disagree, or when one group’s aspirations do not line up perfectly with those of the state as a whole. The key to our success, then, will be our ability to preserve the delicate balance between what unites us and what makes us different. If we will it, this too will be no dream.”

As we stand for Yizkor, let us extend Professor Gavison’s message to our life’s priorities. Let us recall those who gave us a worthy inheritance, and pledge to do the same for those we are so fortunate to influence.

That name comes from the closing line of the Torah reading for the final day of the pilgrimage festivals (when Yizkor is recited): "Every person giving a gift according to the blessing they have received from Adonai" (Deuteronomy 16:17). Offering charitable gifts and performing acts of justice, love, and care in memory of those who have died provide us with ways of honoring their memory and continuing their influence for good.
