Last October, Judy and I went to Manhattan to hear Fania Oz Sulzberger speak about an essay she co-authored with her father, the Israel Prize-winning novelist Amos Oz. A little more than a month later, Amos Oz died. He was 79, and for many years he was seen as the moral compass of liberal Israeli Zionism. His passing will not erase that legacy.

——— Oz was born Amos Klausner, and the story of his youth is told in his memoir *A Tale of Love and Darkness*—later made into a feature film in Hebrew. When he was 14, Amos moved to Kibbutz Hulda, where he embraced the image of the strong, masculine Israeli and the Labor Zionist vision. He wasn't particularly strong or effective at manual labor, but he proved to be a gifted writer, with his novel *My Michael* a best-seller in Israel when he was just 29. He would come to publish 40 books, including 14 novels, winning the Israel Prize for Literature in 1998—one of dozens of literary awards he would receive. His books have been translated into 45 languages, more than any other Israeli writer. Maybe that's because he wrote of universal experiences. "If I were to sum up my books in one word, I would say they are about 'families.' If you gave me two words, I would say 'unhappy families.'"

He became an eloquent voice on the Israeli left, advocating for a two-state solution immediately after the Six Day War. "Even unavoidable occupation is a corrupting occupation," he wrote. But he remained a fervent Zionist, critical of the non-Zionist left, a defender of the 2006 war in Lebanon and the 2014 operation in Gaza, and a supporter of a separation wall. He sought peace, but insisted on Israel's right to self-determination and self-defense.

Amos Oz was staunchly secular, but loved the Jewish literary tradition. The essay he co-authored with his daughter Fania, *Jews and Words*, is a celebration of Hebrew language and literature; they credit words with our ongoing survival. I wrote about *Jews and Words* in my November 2018 Dateline essay, between hearing Fania and Amos' passing. In that essay, I juxtaposed *Jews and Words* with Ronen Bergman's wonderful book about Israel's history of targeted assassinations, *Rise and Kill First*. I am closing with what I wrote there to summarize the impact of Oz's literary and moral legacy.

—————“Every page of *jewsandwords* holds something delightful, but since the authors are Israelis, perhaps this paragraph about the power of their native tongue, Hebrew, should stand out as evidence of the durability of Jews: “Modern Hebrew is the greatest linguistic startup in modern times. During the twentieth century, the count of Hebrew speakers in the world grew from near-zero to more than ten million. There are now, by conservative estimates, six million to seven million native speakers and well over three million nonnative speakers, including Israeli Arabs and diaspora Jews. Think of it this way: more people speak Hebrew today than Danish. Or Lithuanian. Or — we like this one best — Austrian German. Who would have imagined?” (p. 173).

—————“In other words, words are the other weapon that have kept Jews alive. In tandem with military intelligence, we have plenty of ammunition to keep us strong. The lesson that I draw from this month’s reading is that both power and words must be deployed intelligently so that we can continue to thrive.”

—————May we find strength in the words of our tradition at this time of Yizkor and in this season of return.

That name comes from the closing line of the Torah reading for the final day of the pilgrimage festivals (when Yizkor is recited): "Every person giving a gift according to the blessing they have received from Adonai" (Deuteronomy 16:17). Offering charitable gifts and performing acts of justice, love, and care in memory of those who have died provide us with ways of honoring their memory and continuing their influence for good.
